(MAHARASHTRA ANIMAL & FISHERY SCIENCES UNIVERSITY, NAGPUR) DIRECTORATE OF EXTENSION & TRAINING ANNUAL REPORT 2013-14

Introduction : The Government of Maharashtra has established College of Dairy Technology, Udgir (Dist. Latur) on 8th of August 2008 under Marathwada Development Programme as a constituent college of Maharashtra Animal and Fishery Sciences University, Nagpur. The main aim of the institute is to enlighten and empower students by imparting advanced knowledge in the fields of dairy technology by adopting innovative, efficient and effective strategies. The college was started in the small structure belonging to College of Veterinary & Animal Science, Udgir and as temporary arrangement, services of teaching & non-teaching staff were pulled from College of Dairy Technology, Warud (Pusad).

College started functioning in the small building of COVAS, Udgir as temporary arrangement. It was shifted on 26th Jan, 2010 to new structure, which was Goat & Sheep farm. Within short span of time, the college acquired basic facilities required for B. Tech (Dairy Technology) degree programme.

College offering B. Tech (Dairy Technology), a four year degree course based on ICAR pattern and having the intake capacity including ICAR is 36 students. The course curriculum is on line of ICAR, New Delhi, which consist of 8 semesters covering one hands on training and one industrial training at multi-product dairy plant all over the country. Beside this for efficient education, an institute provides facilities such as internet, intranet, website, sport grounds & its materials. Institute initiated various facilities for the students on no loss & no profit basis viz. Transport, Tea/Coffee, photocopy, Lamination, Spiral binding, etc.

College library has collection of 3413 books, costing more than Rs. 40.71 lacs. In addition to this, library dealing with 19 Research, Extension related monthly magazines & periodicals, 08 Marathi & English news papers, the books & Magzines for competitive examinations are also available in the library. The library has soul software & photo copy facility.

Department of Computer Science consists of 32 computers all are with internet facility and made available for staff/students of institute. So as to develop educational skills and to strengthen teaching methods, the class rooms are equipped with audio visual aids such as LCD projector, plasma TV, Interactive white boards with internet facility.

College Gymkhana has good collection of sport materials for national and western games. Basketball, Volleyball, Badminton, Kabaddi, Kho-Kho play grounds for outdoor games are available in the premises. The facilities for indoor games such as Table-Tennis, Chess and Carrom are also made available to the students, for overall development of students different programs viz. Shree Ganesh festival, College foundation day, Fresher's function and orientation programme for newly admitted students and farewell function for the final year outgoing students are being organized.

The NSS activity was commenced from 2009 with 50 volunteers, increased to 60 as regular volunteers and 30 for special activity. Three special camps were organized under NSS at Lohara (11-17, March 2011), Barhalli (17-21 March 2012) and Kavalkhed (22-27, March 2013), respectively.

To execute the different extension activities such as trainings/workshops for milk producer, rural unemployed youth and rural women empowerment, a small Training and Extension cell was developed at the college. The training hall well equipped with various extension aids like Moving trans-slide, LCD Projector, Flex Boards, Khoa machine, Sound system, Television; 03 Glass fabricated Models, 14 Rollup banners, 12 Informative charts, 20 eco solvent boards etc.

Further it is point out that , two students from the first batch of the college secured 1^{st} and 3^{rd} rank in All India Entrance Examination for Post Graduate Studies conducted by ICAR during 2012 and One student from the second batch of the college secured 2^{nd} rank in the same exam conducted by ICAR 2013.

1. Education:

a. Teaching Institutes:

College of Dairy Technology, Udgir was established under MAFSU Nagpur on dated 08th Aug 2008. Under Marathwada development Program Rs.200 Lacks were made available. B. Tech (Dairy Technology) a four year degree course is taught by this institute. The admission eligibility for the degree course is 12th pass with mathematics & science essential. The Intake capacity of the college is 36 students in existing situation 112 students are on roll, out of this 99 are male

students & 13 are female students. 66 students are scholarship holders and 01 student has received Sitaram Jindal Foundation scholarship. Most of the facilities required by the students are available in the institute & equipments are regularly used for effective conduction of practical in different departments. Beside this for efficient education, an institute provides facility such as internet, intranet, website, sport ground & materials and recently started the bus facility on no profit & no loss ground. To develop educational skills and teaching, the college has four class rooms equipped with LCD projector, plasma TV, Interactive white board with Internet facility.
